

Parallel grants from Barncancerfonden

Barncancerfonden has restrictions regarding parallel grants for an individual grant holder. The restrictions are presented in Table 1. Parallel grants are defined as grants with overlapping project periods.

The restrictions are applicable for the main applicant. To be a co-applicant on a grant is not a restriction from applying yourself.

KF: Childhood cancer research months for clinicians *(called TJ until 2022)*

DK: PhD grants for clinicians *(called TJ until 2022)*

MT: Medical technology

PR: Project grants

KP: Clinical project grants

PL: Planning grants

EU: Co-financing of EU projects

OB: Project grants within the area of rare childhood cancer diseases
